Generally Available



SQL Operator with Multiple Output ^{GA} -Route events by content with powerful streaming semantics and lower processing costs

Connectors VNET support ^{PuPr} - Enables Eventstream to ingest real-time data from private networks, including on-premises environments and cloud virtual network

DeltaFlow ^{PuPr} - Transform raw Database CDC feeds into analytics-ready events. Focus on extracting insights .

Eventstream + Spark ^{PuPr} - Start processing streams within minutes with auto-generated PySpark code snippets.

Event time handling - Define event time policies and configure handling for late-arriving and out-of-order events, improving accuracy for time-sensitive scenarios
